Camp Theme

Our summer theme is "On Our Way." Whether walking, wandering, fleeing, or traveling along the way, biblical characters are constantly on a journey of faith with God. Activities are adapted to camper age levels and Episcopal Church teachings and traditions. Daily Discoveries are firmly rooted in Scripture and offer a fun, thoughtful way to explore our relationship to God, one another, and creation.

Each week 45 new campers are greeted by enthusiastic, well trained camp counselors. Volunteer program leaders help to plan and implement programs geared especially to each camper age group. Campers sleep in cabins with 10- 12 campers and two Camp Counselors.
